

MADS ØVLISEN PHD SCHOLARSHIPS

WITHIN ART HISTORY AND PRACTICE-BASED ARTISTIC RESEARCH

OBJECTIVES

The Novo Nordisk Foundation wishes to provide ambitious students with the opportunity to pursue a research career within art history and practice-based artistic research and thereby contribute to developing the fields in Denmark.

With this call, The Novo Nordisk Foundation invites outstanding candidates to apply for a PhD scholarship within art history research and practice-based artistic research.

ELIGIBILITY

The scholarships run for three years and are awarded to highly promising and talented candidates.

The applicant must be enrolled at a university in Denmark during the scholarship period and thus meet admission requirements for a PhD school.

PhD programs that have already started are not eligible for funding.

RESEARCH FIELDS

Five scholarships are available within the following research fields:

- **1 PhD scholarship within art history research before 1900**
- **1 PhD scholarship within art history research after 1900**
- **1 practice-based PhD scholarship in art**
- **1 practice-based PhD scholarship in curating**

- **1 PhD scholarship with an extraordinary potential** applied within any of the above fields or periods.

FUNDING

Each scholarship amounts to DKK 1.6 million in total, covering salary, operational costs, tuition fee and administrative support.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application must be completed and submitted using the Novo Nordisk Foundation's application system, which can be accessed from 29 November 2016 via the foundation's website.

The application can be submitted in English or Danish.
